**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

This bill would provide for the release of the digital photographs taken for driver's licenses by the Department of Motor Vehicles to probation and parole officers.

Current law limits access to such photographs to federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies and other state's driver's license agencies. The law provides that any officer requesting this information shall verify the purpose for requesting the information and shall be subject to a Class IV felony and removal from office if the information is misused.

The intent of the bill is to provide probation and parole officers with the information needed to identify probationers and parolees, to identify victims, particularly in protection order cases, and to identify persons with whom probationers are not allowed to associate.
