**Introducer's Statement of Intent**  
**LB 950**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 950 changes the provisions under Nebraska's duty to stop in the event of accident resulting in personal injury or death (*Nebraska Revised Statutes §60-697 and §60-698*).

Under LB 950, if a person flees an accident which results in an injury to any person, the penalty remains a Class IIIA felony (up to five years).

Under LB 950, if a person flees an accident which results in the death of any person or serious bodily injury, the penalty is a Class III felony (up to twenty years).

The order not to drive and license revocation provisions for both offenses would remain within the range of one to fifteen years.
