

LEGISLATIVE BILL 701A

Approved by the Governor May 1, 2007

Introduced by Louden, 49; Carlson, 38; Christensen, 44

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 701, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$3,000,000 from the General Fund for FY2006-07 to the Department of Natural Resources, for Program 310, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 701, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$3,000,000 from the Water Resources Cash Fund for FY2007-08 and (2) \$3,000,000 from the Water Resources Cash Fund for FY2008-09 to the Department of Natural Resources, for Program 334, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 701, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,083,086 from the General Fund for FY2007-08 and (2) \$2,082,086 from the General Fund for FY2008-09 to the Department of Agriculture, for Program 333, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 701, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$38,323 for FY2007-08 or \$38,323 for FY2008-09.

There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2007-08 \$2,000,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2008-09 \$2,000,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
