Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Inserts express prohibition to the lapse of cash funds associated with commodity promotion programs to the general fund. Section 1 of the bill states legislative findings of the value of commodity promotion programs and that it is in the interest of the state that use of checkoff funds be restricted to their intended purposes. Sections 2 - 9 amend various sections of commodity promotion statutes establishing associated cash funds that are repositories of checkoff assessments collected under authority of the under authority of the underlying programs. The revisions would insert new text pertaining to the permissible use of the funds that expressly prohibits money deposited into the funds or federal funds received by the programs from lapsing to the general fund.
