The bill amends § 60-395, the section dealing with the refund or credit of motor vehicle registration fees, by adding a new subsection (7). The new language states that a motor vehicle or trailer reported stolen shall not have the refund reduced for a lost plate charge if a vehicle has been reported stolen. If the person is applying for a credit to a new vehicle, the credit will be reduced for a lost plate charge, but the applicant shall not be charged a new plate fee. The bill also amends § 60-3,157 to state no duplicate registration or plate fee will be charged if the vehicle or trailer was reported stolen. The fee for a duplicate registration is \$1.00, and the fee for a replacement license plate is \$2.50
