**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 222 restricts a person over the age of eighteen from obtaining a LPD-learner's permit only one time.

This restriction may be waived by the director of the DMV for good cause.

Restrictions on a LPD include having a licensed operator at least twenty-one years of age seated directly beside the permit holder at all times when operating the vehicle. A LPD permit holder is also prohibited from using any type of wireless device while operating the vehicle.
