Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 231 inserts the following clarifications regarding membership on the Rural Development Commission:

- * The bill clarifies that state agency representative appointed by the Governor to the Commission is the director or chief executive officer of the agency or their designated representatives;
 - * The member of the Legislature appointed by the Speaker is a non-voting, ex-officio member of the Commission.

Explanation of amendments:

The Committee amendment adds the Director of the Nebraska State Historical Society or his or her designee as a member of the Commission. The term ex-officio is stricken from the designation of the member of the Legislature appointed by the Speaker. The amendment retains that such member is a non-voting member of the Commission.
