Opponents: Representing: Neutral: Representing: Robert Hallstrom **NE Bankers Association** Summary of purpose and/or changes: LB 32 (Pahls) would amend section 8-113 of the Nebraska Banking Act which currently provides that no individual, firm, company, corporation, or association, other than a bank, building and loan association, savings and loan association, or savings bank, shall use the word "bank" or any derivative thereof as any part of a title or description of any business activity. The bill would expand the existing list of entities to which this prohibition does not apply to include firms, companies, corporations, or associations which sponsor incentive-based solid waste recycling programs which issue reward points or credits to persons for their participation in such a program.

The bill carries the emergency clause.
