Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 379 would change the sunset date for a scrap tire grant program for another five years. Up to one hundred percent of the costs incurred by political subdivisions to clean up scrap tires at collection sites going to approved end-uses are eligible for grant funding.

Details

Section 1 amends 81-15,160, relating to the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund, by changing the date to which grants are available from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2014.

Section 2 repeals the original section.

Section 3 inserts an emergency clause.
