Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 449 would allow a person under age 65 who has been certified by a physician as permanently disabled to return to work as a school employee and continue to collect full disability retirement allowance as long as the employee's monthly income does not exceed the applicable Substantial Gainful Activity (SGA) amounts determined by the Social Security Administration for blind and non-blind persons.

Explanation of amendments:

The Committee Amendment makes the following changes:

1. Strikes the income limitation; and

2. Limits a disability beneficiary employee's hours of work to less than 15 hours per week.
