**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

Legislative Bill 464 would amend section 79-217 to require every student entering seventh grade on or after July 1, 2010 to have a booster immunization containing diphtheria and tetanus toxoids and an acellular pertussis vaccine. The immunization must meet the standards approved by the United States Public Health Service for such biological products, as such standards existed on January 1, 2009.
