Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 49 requires consolidation of motor vehicle services to the county treasurer's office.

Beginning on a date no later than January 1, 2011, the county treasurer of each county shall provide services relating to the issuance of certificates of title, registrations, certificates of number, license plates, renewal decals, the notation and cancellation of liens, and the collection of taxes and fees for all types of vehicles.

After the implementation date, the county treasurer assumes all powers and duties of the county clerk under the State Boat Act and the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act.

Forty-seven of the ninety-three counties have already combined vehicle titling and registration services into one office.
