Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The Wyuka State Cemetery Board currently has three members. LB 498 increases the Board membership from 3 members to 5 members.

Details

Page 2, Lines 6-8 Strikes "who" and Inserts "until July 1, 2009, and thereafter shall be vested in a board of five trustees. The trustees"

Page 2, Line 13 Strikes "to" and Inserts "shall"

Page 3, Lines 1-6 Strikes "The first appointed trustee shall serve until January 1, 1965, the second trustee until January 1, 1967, and the third trustee until January 1, 1969." And Inserts "The two trustees appointed for their initial term of office beginning July 1, 2009, shall be appointed by the Governor to serve a five-year term and a six-year term, respectively."

Page 3, Lines 6-7 Strikes "trustee" and Inserts "of the five trustees"

Page 5, Line 22-23 Contains an Emergency Clause.
