Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 50 changes the definition of motor vehicle in the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing terms to include an engine, transmission, or rear axle. The engine or transmission must have been manufactured for installation in a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 16,000 pounds.

This additional language allows these motor vehicle engine manufacturers who enter into separate agreements with franchised dealers to be governed by the same franchise laws and come under the jurisdiction of the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board.
