LB 505 would establish the Economic Development Committee as a select legislative committee. The committee would meet as necessary to: engage in strategic planning with respect to matters of economic development; develop and promote a consistent and priority-based approach to economic development; and assess the performance of previously enacted economic development measures. The committee could propose legislation.

The six member committee would be appointed by the Executive Board.
