**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 540 changes membership of the Children's Behavioral Health Task Force (section 43-4001). The bill adds the probation administrator or his or her designee to the task force. The bill makes two representatives of the Department of Health and Human Services (department) and the Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Services within the department to be nonvoting ex officio members of the task force.

**Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment (AM 115) removes the two representatives from the Department of Health and Human Services and the Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Services as members of the task force, but adds the probation administrator or his or her designee to the task force.
