Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 677 would have amended the Commercial Dog and Cat Operator Inspection Act to disallow licensure to operate as a commercial breeder after April 1, 2010, if the breeder owns or has custody of more than 75 unaltered dogs over the age of 4 months. The bill would have also inserted additional statutory specification into §54-640 for facility standards and the standards of care maintained by commercial breeders, and proposed additional statutory specification regarding standards for primary enclosures utilized by all licensees. The proposed statutory standards would have largely replicated existing standards for humane handling, care, treatment and transportation of animals promulgated by the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service pursuant to the Animal Welfare Act (9 CFR 3.1 to 3.19). These are currently incorporated as standards governing operations of Nebraska licensees by Department of Agriculture regulations at Chapter 23, article 18, section 007 of the Nebraska Administrative Code.
