Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB690 (Langemeier) would amend sections 87-214 and 87-219 of the trade name statutes to provide that the registrant of a trade name shall publish the trade name within "forty-five" days rather than "thirty" days from the filing in the office of the Secretary of State and shall file proof of publication with the Secretary of State and the county clerk within the "forty-five" days rather than "thirty" days.
