Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB731 expands permissible disposition of certain revenues collected by county weed control authorities to include deposit into the county's general fund if the county does not maintain a noxious weed control fund authorized by Section 2-959. These sections and revenue sources affected include:

- * Section 2-954--funds received by a county weed control authority in the course of enforcement of municipal weed ordinances
 - * Section 2-955--funds collected as reimbursement for weed control actions performed by the county weed control authority on private lands
 - * Section 2-959--funds received from charges for use of equipment owned by the control authority or for weed control services provided
