**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 749 includes the state veteran cemetery in Box Butte County as eligible for available funds out of the State Recreation Road Fund.

The bill amends Sec. 39-1390 to include those roads giving direct and immediate access to the state veteran cemetery in Box Butte County as state recreation roads.

**Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment, AM 1587, strikes the reference to Box Butte County in the bill. This will expand the bill to any current or future state veteran cemetery, and guards against the argument that the bill creates an unconstitutional special class.
