**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

Current law provides that the Clerk of the Legislature shall distribute two copies of the session laws and journal to each member of the Legislature. LB 770 changes this requirement so that only one copy is required, with a second copy to legislators upon request.

**Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment reduces the number of copies of the statutes that the Auditor of Public Accounts receives from three to two. The committee amendment also makes a technical name change in reference to the Nebraska Public Retirement Systems.
