**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 787 statutorily creates a non-voting, ex-officio legislative member of the NITC appointed from the Transportation & Telecommunications Committee.

There is currently an informal legislative liaison member from the Legislature on the NITC. This liaison was initiated by the Governor's office in 2005, and the liaison is currently a nonvoting member.

The bill amends Sec. 86-515 to add a legislative member to the NITC. The member shall be from the Transportation & Telecommunications Committee, and shall be appointed by the Executive Board. The member shall be an ex-officio nonvoting member of the NITC.

The legislative member shall be appointed or reappointed every two years.
