Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 792 would amend the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, by making the following changes:

1. Would correct a spelling error for "5-methoxy-N-N, dimethyltryptamine", to now read as 5-methoxy-N, N-dimethyltryptamine. (P. 7, line 22-23),
 2. Would add Benzylpiperazine, 1-benzylpiperazine as a Schedule I Drug. (P. 12, line 11),
 3. Would make a name correction for "Dextropropoxyphene" to Propoxyphene in nondosage form which is listed as a schedule II drug. (P. 15, line 16),
 4. Would add Tapentadol (opiate) as a schedule II drug. (P. 15 line 24),
 5. Would add (2)Boldione, (6)Desoxymethyltestosterone and (30)19-nor-4, 9(10)-androstadienedione as schedule III drugs under the steroid classification (P.21, lines 14 & 18) and (P. 22, line 17), and
 6. Would make a name correction for "Dextropropoxyphene" to Propoxyphene in manufactured dosage form which is listed as a schedule IV drug. (P. 26, line 17).
