Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 841 authorizes the DMV to release a digital image or digital signature to a law enforcement officer employed in an investigative position by a local agency.

The bill amends Sec. 60-484.02 to expand the DMV's release of a digital image or digital signature to a local agency that has a law enforcement officer on staff who is employed in an investigative position.

During the 2009 session, the Legislature passed LB 372 that authorized the release of a digital image or digital signature to a law enforcement officer employed in an investigative position with a state or federal agency.
