A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 603,
3 One Hundred First Legislature, First Session, 2009; and
4 to reduce appropriations.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,386,548
2 from the General Fund and \$296,548 from federal funds for FY2009-10
3 and (2) \$2,251,029 from the General Fund and \$374,002 from
4 federal funds for FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human
5 Services, for Program 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
6 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
7 2009.

8 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
9 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
10 exceed \$416,659 for FY2009-10 or \$556,012 for FY2010-11.

11 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,111,984
12 from the General Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$2,056,047 from the
13 General Fund for FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human
14 Services, for Program 38, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
15 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
16 2009.

17 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
18 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
19 in this section.

20 Sec. 3. The General Fund appropriation for FY2009-10 to
21 the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 38, is
22 hereby reduced by \$977,697. The General Fund appropriation for
23 FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
24 Program 38, is hereby reduced by \$1,871,577. The reductions in
25 this program assume the implementation of secure residential as

1 a medicaid-covered service on December 1, 2009. If implementation
2 occurs on a date other than December 1, 2009, the Legislature
3 shall adjust the General Fund appropriation based upon the actual
4 implementation date.

5 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,188,116 from
6 the General Fund and \$5,736,969 from federal funds for FY2009-10
7 and (2) \$3,005,553 from the General Fund and \$7,880,187 from
8 federal funds for FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human
9 Services, for Program 344, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
10 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
11 2009.

12 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
13 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
14 in this section.

15 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,221,840
16 from the General Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$2,051,010 from the
17 General Fund for FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human
18 Services, for Program 347, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
19 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
20 2009.

21 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
22 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
23 in this section.

24 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$143,544 from
25 the General Fund and \$1,262,773 from federal funds for FY2009-10

1 and (2) \$314,117 from the General Fund and \$2,421,811 from federal
2 funds for FY2010-11 to the Department of Health and Human Services,
3 for Program 348, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
4 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
5 2009.

6 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
7 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
8 in this section.

9 Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,385,160 from
10 the General Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$1,563,993 from the General
11 Fund for FY2010-11 to the Board of Regents of the University of
12 Nebraska, for Program 781, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
13 Legislative Bill 603, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
14 2009.
