A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to telecommunications; to adopt the Kelsey
- 2 Smith Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 7 of this act shall be known and

- 2 may be cited as the Kelsey Smith Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Kelsey Smith Act:
- 4 (1) Call location information means the best available
- 5 location information, including, but not limited to, information
- 6 obtained using historical cellular site information or a mobile
- 7 locator tool;
- 8 (2) Law enforcement agency means a police department, a
- 9 town marshal, the office of sheriff, and the Nebraska State Patrol;
- 10 (3) Wireless carrier has the same meaning as in section
- 11 86-456; and
- 12 <u>(4) Wireless communication device means any wireless</u>
- 13 electronic communication device that provides for voice or data
- 14 communication between two or more parties, including a mobile or
- 15 cellular telephone.
- 16 Sec. 3. Upon request of any law enforcement agency, a
- 17 wireless carrier shall provide call location information concerning
- 18 the wireless communication device of a user as soon as practicable
- 19 following receipt of the request to facilitate the response to
- 20 a call for emergency services or in an emergency situation that
- 21 involves the risk or threat of death or serious physical harm.
- 22 Sec. 4. No cause of action shall lie in any court against
- 23 any wireless carrier or its officers, employees, agents, or assigns
- 24 for providing call location information while acting at the request
- 25 of a law enforcement agency in accordance with the provisions

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1 of the Kelsey Smith Act. All wireless carriers shall be held

- 2 harmless from any and all claims, damages, costs, and expenses,
- 3 including attorney's fees, arising from or related to the release
- 4 of call location information while acting at the request of a law
- 5 enforcement agency.
- 6 Sec. 5. (1) Any wireless carrier authorized to do
- 7 business in this state or submitting to the jurisdiction of this
- 8 state shall provide updated contact information to the Nebraska
- 9 State Patrol on a semiannual basis or within three working days
- 10 after a change in such information that would render previous
- 11 contact information invalid or inefficient for use under the Kelsey
- 12 Smith Act.
- 13 (2) The Nebraska State Patrol shall collect and maintain
- 14 a register of contact information for all such wireless carriers.
- 15 Sec. 6. The Nebraska State Patrol shall provide the
- 16 information collected pursuant to section 5 of this act to all law
- 17 enforcement agencies in this state on a quarterly basis or as soon
- 18 as practicable if a change in such information has occurred.
- 19 Sec. 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 20 contrary, nothing in the Kelsey Smith Act shall prohibit a wireless
- 21 <u>carrier from establishing protocols by which the wireless carrier</u>
- 22 could voluntarily disclose call location information.
