A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend  
2 section 60-6,268, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;  
3 to eliminate the requirements that occupant protection  
4 system laws be enforced as a secondary action; to  
5 outright section 60-6,271, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
6 Nebraska; and to repeal the original section.  
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 60-6,268, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3           60-6,268 ~~(1)~~ A person violating any provision of  
4 subsection (1) of section 60-6,267 shall be guilty of an infraction  
5 as defined in section 29-431 and shall be fined twenty-five dollars  
6 for each violation. The failure to provide a child restraint system  
7 for more than one child in the same vehicle at the same time, as  
8 required in such subsection, shall not be treated as a separate  
9 offense.

10           ~~(2) Enforcement of subdivision (1)(b) and subsection (6)~~  
11 ~~of section 60-6,267 shall be accomplished only as a secondary~~  
12 ~~action when an operator of a motor vehicle has been cited or~~  
13 ~~charged with a violation or some other offense unless the violation~~  
14 ~~involves a person under the age of eighteen years riding in or on~~  
15 ~~any portion of the vehicle not designed or intended for the use of~~  
16 ~~passengers when the vehicle is in motion.~~
