Section 1. Section 76-2317, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 76-2317 Underground facility shall mean means any item 4 of personal property buried or placed below ground for use in connection with the storage or conveyance of water, sewage, 5 6 electronic communications, telephonic communications, telegraphic 7 communications, cable television, electric energy, oil, gas, 8 hazardous liquids, or other substances, including pipes, trunk lines, fiber optic cables, sewers, conduits, cables, valves, 9 10 lines, wires, manholes, and attachments to such personal property. 11 Underground facility does not include sanitary sewer lines and 12 storm sewer lines owned by a sanitary and improvement district which are located in a public right-of-way or in an easement owned 13 14 by the sanitary and improvement district.
