A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the statewide one-call notification system;  
2 to amend section 76-2317, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
3 Nebraska; to redefine the term underground facility; and  
4 to repeal the original section.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 76-2317, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   76-2317 Underground facility ~~shall mean~~ means any item  
4 of personal property buried or placed below ground for use in  
5 connection with the storage or conveyance of water, sewage,  
6 electronic communications, telephonic communications, telegraphic  
7 communications, cable television, electric energy, oil, gas,  
8 hazardous liquids, or other substances, including pipes, trunk  
9 lines, fiber optic cables, sewers, conduits, cables, valves,  
10 lines, wires, manholes, and attachments to such personal property.  
11 Underground facility does not include sanitary sewer lines and  
12 storm sewer lines owned by a sanitary and improvement district  
13 which are located in a public right-of-way or in an easement owned  
14 by the sanitary and improvement district.

15                   Sec. 2. Original section 76-2317, Reissue Revised  
16 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
