Section 1. Section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 43-536 In determining the rate of reimbursement for child
- 4 care, the Department of Health and Human Services shall conduct a
- 5 market rate survey of the child care providers in the state. The
- 6 department shall adjust the reimbursement rate for child care every
- 7 odd-numbered year at a rate not less than the sixtieth fiftieth
- 8 percentile and not to exceed the seventy-fifth percentile of the
- 9 current market rate survey, except that (1) nationally accredited
- 10 child care providers may be reimbursed at higher rates. and (2) for
- 11 the two fiscal years beginning July 1, 2003, such rate may be less
- 12 than the sixtieth percentile but shall not be less than the rate
- 13 for the immediately preceding fiscal year.
- 14 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2009.
- 15 Sec. 3. Original section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 16 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 17 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 18 when passed and approved according to law.
