1	Section 1. (1) A person who, in good faith, seeks medical
2	assistance for a person experiencing a drug-related overdose shall
3	not be charged or prosecuted for possession of a controlled
4	substance pursuant to section 28-416 if the evidence for the charge
5	of possession of a controlled substance was gained as a result of
6	seeking medical assistance.
7	(2) A person who experiences a drug-related overdose and
8	seeks medical assistance shall not be charged or prosecuted for
9	possession of a controlled substance pursuant to section 28-416 if
10	the evidence for the charge of possession of a controlled substance
11	was gained as a result of the overdose and the need for medical
12	assistance.
13	(3) The act of seeking medical assistance for a person
14	who is experiencing a drug-related overdose may be used as a
15	mitigating factor in a criminal prosecution pursuant to the Uniform
16	Controlled Substances Act.
