A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to scrap metal; to amend section 69-404,  
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to  
3 change payment terms relating to copper and catalytic  
4 converters; and to repeal the original section.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 69-404, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:

3                   69-404 No secondary metals recycler shall purchase  
4 regulated metals property for cash consideration unless the  
5 purchase total is not more than twenty-five dollars. Purchases  
6 made from the same person within a four-hour period shall be  
7 considered a single transaction. Payment shall be made payable only  
8 to the individual named on the identification presented pursuant  
9 to section 69-402. Payment for copper and catalytic converters  
10 shall be by check. The check shall be held by the secondary metals  
11 recycler for a period of three days. At the end of the three-day  
12 hold on payment, the check shall be mailed to the vendor of the  
13 regulated metals property to the address on record.

15 Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is repealed.
