Section 1. Section 60-6,102, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 60-6,102 (1) In the case of a driver who dies within four hours after being in a motor vehicle accident, including a 4 5 motor vehicle accident in which one or more persons in addition 6 to such driver is killed, and of a pedestrian sixteen years of 7 age or older who dies within four hours after being struck by a 8 motor vehicle, the coroner or other official performing the duties 9 of coroner shall examine the body and cause such tests to be made 10 as are necessary to determine the amount of alcohol or and drugs 11 in the body of such driver or pedestrian. Such information shall 12 be included in each report submitted pursuant to sections 60-6,101 13 to 60-6,104 and shall be tabulated on a monthly basis by the Department of Roads. Such information, including the identity of 14 15 the deceased and any such amount of alcohol or and drugs, shall be 16 public information and may be released or disclosed as provided in rules and regulations of the department. 17

18 (2) For purposes of this section, drugs means controlled
 19 substances enumerated in section 28-405.
