(1) A person commits the offense of assault on 21 an emergency services provider or a health care provider in the 22 first degree if he or she intentionally or knowingly causes serious 23 bodily injury to an emergency services provider or a health care 24 provider while such emergency services provider or health care 25 provider is engaged in the performance of his or her official

4	(2) Assault on an emergency services provider or a health
5	care provider in the first degree is a Class II felony.
6	Sec. 4. (1) A person commits the offense of assault on an
7	emergency services provider or a health care provider in the second
8	degree if he or she:
9	(a) Intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury with
10	a dangerous instrument to an emergency services provider or a
11	health care provider while such emergency services provider or
12	health care provider is engaged in the performance of his or her
13	official duties, with knowledge that the person against whom the
14	assault is committed is an emergency services provider or a health
15	care provider; or
16	(b) Recklessly causes bodily injury with a dangerous
17	instrument to an emergency services provider or a health care
18	provider while such emergency services provider or health care
19	provider is engaged in the performance of his or her official
20	duties.
21	(2) Assault on an emergency services provider or a health
22	care provider in the second degree is a Class III felony.
23	Sec. 5. (1) A person commits the offense of assault on
24	an emergency services provider or a health care provider in the
25	third degree if he or she intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly
