A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 669,
3 One Hundred First Legislature, First Session, 2009; to
4 provide an operative date; and to declare an emergency.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$457,260 from
2 the General Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$458,145 from the General
3 Fund for FY2010-11 to the Supreme Court, for Program 6, to aid in
4 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 669, One Hundred
5 First Legislature, First Session, 2009.

6 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
7 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
8 exceed \$377,070 for FY2009-10 or \$377,070 for FY2010-11.

9 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$297,950 from
10 the General Fund for FY2009-10 and (2) \$298,540 from the General
11 Fund for FY2010-11 to the Supreme Court, for Program 7, to aid in
12 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 669, One Hundred
13 First Legislature, First Session, 2009.

14 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
15 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
16 exceed \$244,586 for FY2009-10 or \$244,586 for FY2010-11.

17 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$338,765 from
18 the General Fund and \$22,800 from the Supreme Court Education Fund
19 for FY2009-10 and (2) \$331,265 from the General Fund and \$22,800
20 from the Supreme Court Education Fund for FY2010-11 to the Supreme
21 Court, for Program 52, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
22 Legislative Bill 669, One Hundred First Legislature, First Session,
23 2009.

24 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
25 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not

1 exceed \$202,679 for FY2009-10 or \$202,679 for FY2010-11.

2 Sec. 4. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2009.

3 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
4 when passed and approved according to law.
