A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section
2 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2009; to provide
3 for issuance of disabled veteran license plates as
4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-3,124, Revised Statutes Supplement,
2 2009, is amended to read:

3 60-3,124 (1) Any person who is a veteran of the United
4 States Armed Forces, who was discharged or otherwise separated
5 with a characterization of honorable or general (under honorable
6 conditions), and who is classified by the United States Department
7 of Veterans Affairs as one hundred percent service-connected
8 disabled may, in addition to the application required in section
9 60-385, apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for license
10 plates designed by the department to indicate that the applicant is
11 a disabled veteran. The inscription on the license plates shall be
12 D.A.V. immediately below the license plate number to indicate that
13 the holder of the license plates is a disabled veteran.

14 (2) The plates shall be issued upon the applicant paying
15 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
16 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
17 is a disabled veteran. The additional fee shall be remitted to the
18 State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System
19 Operation Fund. ~~Only one motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or~~
20 ~~cabin trailer owned by the applicant shall be so licensed at any~~
21 ~~one time. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, or~~
22 ~~cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any one~~
23 ~~time.~~ Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section 60-3,198
24 shall not be so licensed.

1 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be
2 issued replacement license plates as provided in section 60-3,157.
