- 3 81-2001 (1) There is hereby established a department
- 4 to be known as the Nebraska State Patrol. The chief officer of
- 5 the Nebraska State Patrol shall be the Superintendent of Law
- 6 Enforcement and Public Safety.
- 7 (2) Until January 1, 2011, the superintendent 7 who shall
- 8 have had at least four years' experience as a law enforcement
- 9 officer prior to his or her appointment. On and after January 1,
- 10 2011, prior to his or her appointment, the superintendent shall
- 11 have:
- 12 <u>(a) A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or</u>
- 13 <u>university;</u>
- 14 (b) At least fifteen years of law enforcement experience;
- 15 (c) At least five years of management experience in law
- 16 enforcement; and
- 17 (d) A certificate of successful completion of command
- 18 officer training offered by a nationally recognized program.
- 19 (3) For purposes of sections 81-2001 to 81-2010,
- 20 superintendent means the Superintendent of Law Enforcement and
- 21 Public Safety.
