A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Chiropractic Practice Act; to amend  
2 section 38-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to  
3 exclude licensed physical therapists; and to repeal the  
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 38-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3           38-806 The Chiropractic Practice Act shall not be  
4 construed to include the following classes of persons:

5           (1) Licensed physicians and surgeons, ~~and~~ licensed  
6 osteopathic physicians, and licensed physical therapists who  
7 are exclusively engaged in the practice of their respective  
8 professions;

9           (2) Physicians who serve in the armed forces of the  
10 United States or the United States Public Health Service or who  
11 are employed by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs  
12 or other federal agencies, if their practice is limited to that  
13 service or employment;

14           (3) Chiropractors licensed in another state when  
15 incidentally called into this state in consultation with a  
16 chiropractor licensed in this state; or

17           (4) Students enrolled in an accredited college of  
18 chiropractic when the services performed are a part of the course  
19 of study and are under the direct supervision of a licensed  
20 chiropractor.

21           Sec. 2. Original section 38-806, Reissue Revised Statutes  
22 of Nebraska, is repealed.
