5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 16-707, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

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3 16-707 The mayor and council shall meet as a board of equalization on the first Monday in June of each year and at 4 5 such other times as they shall determine to be necessary, giving notice of any such sitting at least ten days prior thereto by 6 7 publication in a newspaper having general circulation in the city. 8 When so assembled they shall have power to equalize all special 9 assessments, not herein otherwise provided for, and to supply any 10 omissions in the same; and at such meeting the assessments shall 11 be finally levied by them. A majority of all the members elected 12 to the council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of 13 any business properly brought before them, but a less number may 14 adjourn from time to time and compel the attendance of absent 15 members. When sitting as a board of equalization on special taxes, 16 the council may adopt such reasonable rules as to the manner of 17 presenting complaints and applying for remedies and relief as shall 18 seem just. It shall not invalidate or prejudice the proceedings 19 of the board that a majority of the members thereof do not, after 20 organization by a majority, continue present during the advertised 21 hours of sitting τ provided so long as the city clerk or some 22 member of the board shall be present to receive complaints and 23 applications, and give information. No $+ \frac{Provided}{100}$ no final action shall be taken by the board except by a majority of all the 24 25 members elected to the city council comprising the same, and in

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open session. All the special taxes herein authorized shall be 1 2 levied and assessed on all lots, parts of lots, lands, and real 3 estate to the extent of the special benefit to such lots, parts of lots, lands, and real estate, by reason of such improvement, 4 5 such benefits to be determined by the council sitting as a board 6 of equalization, or as otherwise herein provided, after publication 7 and notice to property owners herein provided. In cases where the 8 council sitting as a board of equalization shall find such benefits to be equal and uniform, such assessments may be according to 9 10 the feet frontage and may be prorated and scaled back from the 11 line of such improvement according to such rules as the board 12 of equalization may consider fair and equitable; and all such 13 assessments and findings of benefits shall not be subject to review in any equitable or legal action except for fraud, injustice, or 14 15 mistake.

Sec. 2. Original section 16-707, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.

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
