## LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 431

Introduced by Haar, 21.

PURPOSE: To study how private sources of money given to public institutions should be disclosed. This study should look at how private money is being directed to public bodies. It should also seek to find out information about private money donated to the state, local governing bodies, and higher education and how it currently is reported. This study should seek ways to ensure public budgets are transparent so that the public knows where its tax money is going and what the influence of private money has on public bodies. This study should also look into whether disclosure of private money could be required of all governmental institutions and whether such disclosure could be done in a way that protects donor anonymity and does not harm institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
