Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 1004

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

To allow for the operation of golf car vehicle or low-speed vehicle during daytime on any highway on which the speed limit is not more than thirty-five miles per hour. A golf car vehicle or low-speed vehicle may cross a highway on which the speed limit is more than thirty-five miles per hour.

LB 1004 does not prevent a county, city, or village from adopting more stringent ordinances governing golf car vehicle or low-speed vehicle operation if the governing body of the county, city, or village determines that such ordinances are necessary in the interest of public safety.
