

One Hundred First Legislature - Second Session - 2010 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 1072

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 1072 changes provisions related to the Community College Foundation and Equalization Aid Act, which is used to determine the distribution of state aid and general fund levy authority available to community college areas. The bill would rename the act the Community College Equalization Aid Act. In addition, the bill provides for new categories and factor weightings in determining reimbursable educational units, provides additional duties for the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education with respect to community colleges, and makes modifications to community college role and mission statutes. LB 1072 also makes membership in an association of community college boards permissive rather than mandatory.

The bill contains an emergency	clause.
