The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 108 would provide that a licensed motor vehicle dealer acquiring an all-terrain vehicle may apply for a certificate of title after obtaining a signed affidavit from the seller and verifying with the county sheriff that the vehicle is not listed as stolen according to the National Crime Information Center or the Nebraska Crime Information Service.

The bill allows the county sheriff five days to check the records and respond to the dealer.

LB 108 would also eliminate the requirement that such vehicles must be inspected for identification.
