The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 110 creates a specialty license plate program administered by the Department of Motor Vehicles. A qualified non-profit organization may apply to the DMV to design specialty plates for the organization. 150 prepaid applications are required before such plate will be issued. The plates will cost \$100, with \$15 going to the DMV Cash Fund and \$85 going to the Highway Trust Fund.

The bill also increases the costs for personalized message plates and Husker Spirit plates. The fee for message plates will increase from \$30 to \$60, and the fee for Spirit plates will increase from \$70 to \$100. All increased fees will be directed to the Highway Trust Fund.

In addition, the \$5 extra fee charged to all existing military plates will be redirected to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Fund.
