The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Each judge of the county court, in counties having more than 100,000 inhabitants, is allowed to contract with a constable to serve legal process. Current law authorizes litigants to designate which constable should serve process in his or her case. LB 203 would eliminate the ability of litigants to select the process server and instead have the constable designated by the court.
