

One Hundred First Legislature - First Session - 2009 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 28

Date of Hearing: January 27, 2009

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 28 authorizes the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue undercover license plates and drivers' licenses to federal law enforcement agencies, when used only for legitimate criminal investigatory purposes.

The federal law enforcement agency shall designate a contact person and submit an application on a form prescribed by the director. Prior to issuing the plates or licenses, the director shall determine whether they will be used for a legitimate purpose. The records regarding the application and issuance shall be kept confidential. The plates and licenses shall be returned to the director upon completion of their purpose or upon the director's request. All fees normally required for a plate or license must accompany any application.
