The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 470 establishes a maximum occupation tax rate of six percent on telecommunications companies or telecommunications services.

LB 470 applies this six percent maximum rate to:

- 1. Cities of the metropolitan class
- 2. Cities of the primary class
- 3. Cities of the first class
- 4. Second-class cities and villages
