

One Hundred First Legislature - First Session - 2009 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 490

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 490 would limit non-resident hunting permits to periods of ten consecutive days. Current law allows two types of non-resident hunting permits: 1) an annual non-resident hunting permit; or 2) a special two-day non-resident hunting permit, only available during the winter holiday season. By restricting the length of non-resident hunting permits, LB 490 is designed to reduce congestion in certain border regions of the state where non-resident hunters vastly outnumber resident hunters.
