

One Hundred First Legislature - First Session - 2009 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 517

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 517 adds additional exceptions for not reunifying the family and for termination of parental rights due to parental convictions of felony assaults.

The bill provides that the court shall not be required to reunify the family if a parent of a juvenile who has been convicted of felony sexual assault of the other parent or a comparable crime in another state. Additionally, the court may terminate all parental rights if one parent has been convicted of felony sexual assault of the other parent or a comparable crime in another state.
