Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 527

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 527 intends to improve efficiencies with regard to state motor vehicle fleets by requiring each state owned motor vehicle to be equipped with an automatic vehicle location system (AVLS) device beginning in 2011. AVLS contains both a global positioning satellite device and a central computerized tracking system. Installation of such devices would allow state agencies to monitor vehicle performance, improve maintenance and track adherence to proper use standards by employees. To provide greater public transparency, the bill further requires that the tracking system be made reasonably accessible via public website.
